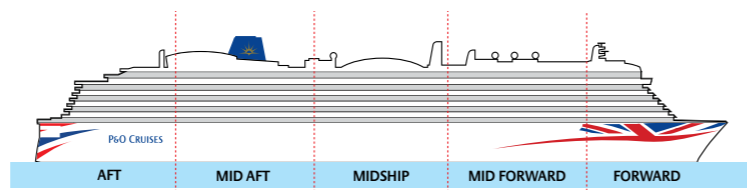

Δ Cabins have obstructed view. **Note:** All pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge. All cabins on Iona have shower only apart from Suites - B4, B5 & B6 grades.
